CAMP ASSISTANT VOLUNTEER

JOB DESCRIPTION

Classification Responsibilities: A Camp Assistant Volunteer is responsible for supporting the Museum's summer camp experiences by helping create a fun, safe, and engaging environment for children. Duties include assisting Museum educators with themed art and STEM activities, preparing and cleaning up materials, and encouraging camper creativity and participation. Volunteers must attend a training session prior to the camp's start and commit to a one-week shift.

Distinguishing Features: A Camp Assistant Volunteer will work closely with the education team and gain hands-on experience facilitating interactive learning in a camp setting. This short-term, high-impact opportunity is ideal for individuals interested in education, child development, or museum work. Camp Assistants Volunteers report to Museum educators and may receive direction from other staff or volunteers.

QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum Qualifications Required. Must be at least 15 years old. Enthusiasm for working with children, creativity, and teamwork is required. Experience with camps, classrooms, or museums is a plus but not necessary.

Special Requirements. A background check may be required depending on the applicant's age.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Communication: Must interact professionally with Museum staff, campers, and other volunteers. Volunteers should demonstrate a friendly demeanor and strong communication skills when engaging children and supporting learning experiences.

Manual/Physical: Ability to assist with the setup and cleanup of activity areas, handle basic materials, and supervise children in a camp setting. Extended periods of standing and occasional lifting up to 25 pounds may be required.

Mental: Must be able to follow instructions, remain flexible in a dynamic environment, and respond to the needs of campers with patience and care.

Ability to:

engage positively with young learners; collaborate with Museum staff and peers; maintain a clean, safe, and welcoming environment; follow schedules and safety protocols; and attend required training prior to camp.
